

POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCROTAL SURGERY

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF INFECTION INCLUDE:

Fever above 101° orally. Large amount of swelling. Redness, foul drainage, soreness, or warmth at surgery site.

If you have:

Severe pain that is not relieved by pain medications, please call our office at 402-421-8899 or after hours at 402-489-8888.

Bleeding that is not controlled after pressure to the surgical site is held for 10 minutes, call our office at 402-421-8899 or after hours at 402-489-8888.

Swelling of the scrotum after any kind of scrotal surgery (vasectomy, hydrocelectomy, spermatocelectomy, vasectomy reversal, orchiectomy, etc.). Please replace your athletic support or compression shorts to help decrease swelling and discomfort. If this does not relieve the pain and decrease the swelling please call our office at 402-421-8899 of after hours at 402-489-8888.
